

Lola Ridge Journal Publication 1892-1920

Michelle Leggott

The earliest known publication from Ridge's 1905 collection 'Verses' dates from 1892 in New Zealand; the last poem published from the collection appeared in 1920 in New York, after the poet had adopted free verse and was making her American reputation with *The Ghetto* and *Sun-Up*. I am indebted to Roger Collins, who located Ridge's *Canterbury Times* poems, and to Elaine Sproat for references to some of Ridge's post-1908 journal publication, and for copies of the extant pages of the revised 'Verses' typescript.
